Dear Parent/Carer

The Education Act 1999 requires schools to notify parents of all contributions and charges prior to the start of the school year. These costs are divided into four areas: **School Contributions, Charges, Personal Items List and Extra Cost Options.**

- **School Contributions:** A voluntary school contribution goes towards the cost of items used in the educational program provided for your child.
- **Extra Cost Options:** An estimate of the costs of these items is listed for non-compulsory activities. Payment for these items is a condition of participation by students, such as swimming, incursions, excursions and dance programs. You will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.
- **Personal Items List:** Items on this list are required for students use. Parents may purchase these items from their chosen retailer and are required on day one. We recommend a quality brand as they last longer. Please label all items to minimise unnecessary loss. Each student is required to supply these items for their class and for their personal use. They may need to be replenished during the year.
- **Charges:** This term refers to any costs for which payment is **compulsory**. For example, PEAC, Instrumental Hire for Music.

SCHOOL VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

The Coolbellup Community School Board has endorsed an amount of \$60 per student as a School Contribution for 2024. These contributions are voluntary and enhance the teaching and learning opportunities for all students and supplement funding gained from other sources. The School Contributions will be used to purchase supplementary materials and resources used in classrooms such as:
