

## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Parent Community

This is the final newsletter for the term. The newsletter scheduled for last week did not go out due to the sports carnival.

Thank you for the kind words about my health from staff, students and parents. I returned to work last Monday, fully recovered. I like to think I was missed!

The two pieces of play equipment on the oval which have been condemned as being unsafe are scheduled to be removed during the holidays. Both of the schools have committed funds towards a replacement playground, but the amounts we can commit are somewhat less than the \$100,000 we need to put back something similar. The P&C have been very proactive in exploring avenues of funding outside of the Education Department, as well as launching a very active fund raising program. I am very grateful for their commitment and industry. We are hoping to have a new playground in place sooner rather than later.

This term has been somewhat more settled than the previous one. Term 3 was very productive and a return to 'almost normal'. Our learning programs and timetables returned to normal, the children were at school from day one, we were able to host assemblies, parents were able to access the school as they needed and we could hold our sports carnival.

I am assuming that Term 4 will be even more normal, albeit very busy, as the calendar is very full. There are still some aspects of COVID-19 restrictions remaining, including the requirement for adults to maintain the 1.5m social distancing and the enhanced school cleaning continuing into Term 4. The need for the children to wash their hands regularly has always been a part of our normal health education message, so this will continue to be a priority.

Term 4 commences on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> October, with Monday 12<sup>th</sup> being pupil free.

I wish all of our children and their families a safe and relaxing holiday.

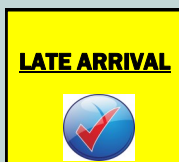
