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## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Parent Community

Welcome back to school for Term 4. As usual it is jam packed. Each week there seems to be something significant happening.

Next week is Book Week, which culminates in a dress up day on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> October. The theme of Book Week this year is "Curious Creatures, Curious Minds". The children are invited to dress up as their favourite book character. They will be parading their creativity at a brief assembly starting at around 9am. We also have a girls' multisport carnival happening next week.

The lifting of some COVID-19 restrictions have enabled us to proceed with camp this year. This year we will be away for Week 4, Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> to Friday 6<sup>th</sup> November. I am hoping for some warmer weather, even in November it can be a little cool in Busselton.

During the holidays the Spida and Web play equipment was removed. At the moment there is a yellow sand pit on the site. The reticulation is being repaired to water the area and then turf will be installed to cover the sand. We are hoping to have replacement play equipment installed sooner than later.

The prizes for the fun run have arrived at the school and will be distributed next week.

I have had some enquiries from parents regarding the time school is open in the morning. Teachers are rostered to the undercover area to supervise the children from 8:15am. This is for Breakfast Club. At 8:30am the children are released from the undercover area to go to class. Breakfast Club finishes main service at around this time. Late comers are never turned away, but they need to finish eating and be at class before the official start time at 8:45am. The best arrival time for children attending Breakfast Club is 8:15am. The sweet spot for children arriving at school and not attending Breakfast Club is 8:30am.

Please do not send children to school before 8:15am.

The children are not permitted to ride bicycles, scooters or roller skates in the school grounds. This is for safety reasons. This includes the footpaths. I have on occasion also seen parents riding bikes in the school. I would respectfully ask that parents also do not ride bikes in the school.

I am looking forward to a productive and busy term.
