Welcome to the P & C:

The P & C is a joint body of both the Coolbellup Community School and the Coolbellup Learning Centre. The P&C consist of individual parents and carers of students enrolled in both schools. The P & C committee is made up of elected members and consists of

a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and a number of committee members.



The P&C holds its AGM every March and meets regularly twice a term. The P&C's annual membership fee is set at \$1.00

The P&C supports the schools in many ways including graduation, fundraising & input into school decision making it also provides a representative to the joint Schools' Council.

FUNDRAISING

The P&C amongst its other roles raises money for the schools by fundraising. Annual events such as Mother's & Father's Day stalls, Easter raffles and additional events each year raise the bulk of funds. Each year the P&C ask the schools to suggest projects for the P&C to fundraise for. Previous items purchased by the P&C include, K/PP area play equipment, an outdoor clock for the covered area and numerous class and graduation book prizes. In addition the P&C often subsidises joint school events such as Harmony Day.

Canteen

The P&C runs the Schools' canteen which operates two days a week, Thursdays and Fridays. The P&C employs a Canteen Manager and relies on the voluntary assistance of parents/carers to assist with its running. The canteen operates under the Department of Education's Healthy Eating Policy and abides by the 'Red, Green and Amber' Traffic Light categories. All care is taken to meet the needs of students with allergies particularly to nuts and eggs. Volunteers assisting in the canteen are rewarded with one free lunch for their child. The canteen also sells special products such as 'Birthday Boxes' for your child's special day and offers special menus for multicultural days, sports carnivals and other events.



THE UNIFORM SHOP

The P&C runs the uniform shop for both schools. A range of styles are available in the school colours of teal green and black.

The uniform shop is located in the Community Room in the Undercover area and is open every Tuesday afternoon 2.30– 3.00pm and Friday mornings. Winter and Summer uniforms are for sale with a limited number of pre-loved items. Order forms are available from the schools' front office and the Community Room. Special order shirts for Year 7 graduation are also available each year.

SCHOOL BANKING

School Banking is a service offered by the P&C. The school bank operates from the Community Room Thursday and Friday between 8.30 am and 8.50am. The P & C receives commissions for all monies banked each week.

WACSSO

WACSSO is the WA Council of State Schools Organisation and is the peak body for school P&C's. Our P&C is an affiliate to WACSSO who provide a range of training and advice for members as required. WACSSO also represents the views of P&Cs across the state.
