Carpark Reminders

Once again I am asking that parents put the safety of our students/visitors ahead of convenience and think about the following points:

At this stage our school does not have a designated 'kiss and drive' drop off. Although personal reminders are given as often as possible, many drivers continue to use the approach to the crossing which connects the carpark and the breeze-way into the school building as a place to drop their child/ren off and pick them up at the end of the day. This puts the safety of our students at risk, as while cars are standing on the left side, the cars behind do not have a clear view of students who may be approaching the cross walk. Although students are reminded about road safety at every opportunity, they can be unpredictable and sometimes cross without first looking.

There are limited disabled parking bays that are located close to ramps and wheelchair access. It is very frustrating to parents/carers who require the use of these bays only to find them taken by visitors who are able to use the regular car bays. Please be considerate of others by only using the designated disabled bays if you have a valid ACROD permit.
